IS YOUR CAT PROTECTED IF IT GETS LOST?

Did you adopt a microchipped cat or have your cat chipped at a vet or clinic? Have you made an account with the microchip company and filled out your contact information? If not, your cat is at risk! In the past few months, multiple lost cats have come into foster care who had microchips—but the owners never registered the chip and we weren't able to find them through available records.

Don't delay! Find your cat's microchip information and register it now!

REGISTER YOUR CNYCC MICROCHIP NOW!

Most CNYCC cats are chipped through 24Petwatch. Your adoption paperwork includes the microchip number and registration website. Chip registration is FREE (you may see paid upgrades, but the basic registration has no cost). To register your cat's 24Petwatch chip:

- > Visit mypethealth.com
- > Click "Create Account from Microchip"
- Follow instructions to enter your contact details and the cat's microchip number and description
- > Your cat is now registered for life!
